Rules for admission of students to study in Phuket Thai Hua Asean Wittaya School

Secondary Year 4, Academic Year 2022

1. Qualifications of applicants

1) Language-Arts MICP Program

1. Currently studying or completing Mathayom 3 from schools across the country

2. Have a minimum grade point average of Grade 1-3 in Chinese and English subjects at least 2.75

3. Students do not have serious contagious diseases which hinder their studies.

4. Students have diligence, good behavior and personality.

5. Students intend to attend Phuket Thai Hua Asean Wittaya School and receive support from their parents.

6. Students have a basic knowledge of Chinese.

2) Art – Mathematics Program

1. Currently studying or completing Mathayom 3 from schools across the country

2. A minimum grade point average of 2.75 in Mathematics and English.

3. Students do not have serious contagious diseases which hinder their studies.

4. Students have diligence, good behavior and personality.

5. Students intend to attend Phuket Thai Hua Asean Wittaya School and receive support from their parents.

6. Students have a basic knowledge of Chinese.

3) Science-Mathematics Program

1. Currently studying or completing Mathayom 3 from schools across the country

2. Having a grade point average of Mathayom 1-3 in science and mathematics subjects not less than 2.75

3. Students do not have serious contagious diseases which hinder their studies.

4. Students have diligence, good behavior and personality.
